ENGLAND'S COLONIES.

It is not easy to understand the attitude of England towards her colonies.

Quite recently the Pall Mall Gazette of London published an interview with Rev. Dr. Hawley, a Catholic clergyman of Newfoundland.

Commenting upon this the Gazette says the situation is really serious, and notes the absurdity of Lord Salisbury moving heaven and earth to prevent the imaginary danger of losing Ireland.

We are not sure that we want Newfoundland, but that has nothing to do with England's conduct towards her colonies.

England should do one of two things. She should either bind her colonies more closely to her by legislating in their behalf and by treating their citizens on equal terms with the citizens of the British Isles.
