QUESTIONS IN DISPUTE.

The seizure of the Black Diamond by the revenue cutter Rush, and the subsequent action of the Black Diamond's captain in refusing to acknowledge the force of the seizure by sailing to Victoria instead of Sitka, has brought the subject again prominently before the country.
