AMERICAN STEAMSHIPS.

At the International American congress which is to meet in Washington in October every country of Central and South America will have a proposition to submit relative to the establishment of a line steamships between their country and the United States.

What will the United States do? Shall we have to tell the delegates from the South and Central American nations that, because certain corporations imposed upon the United States government some years ago and abused the confidence of the nation, no man in the halls of congress dares to mention the word "subsidy," no matter how useful the purpose which a subsidy might subserve?

We, the people of the United States, are very fond of boasting of our enormous wealth and our material progress, and as compared with the countries of the Old World we have ample justification for our boasting; but when comparisons come to be drawn between the United States and such wide-awake go-ahead nations as Chile and the Argentine Republic, it may be that modesty will become us better than vaingloriousness, and that the eagle's scream had better be hushed.
