On Friday the team of William Jones was drowned at Wheatland, about 12 miles below Salem.

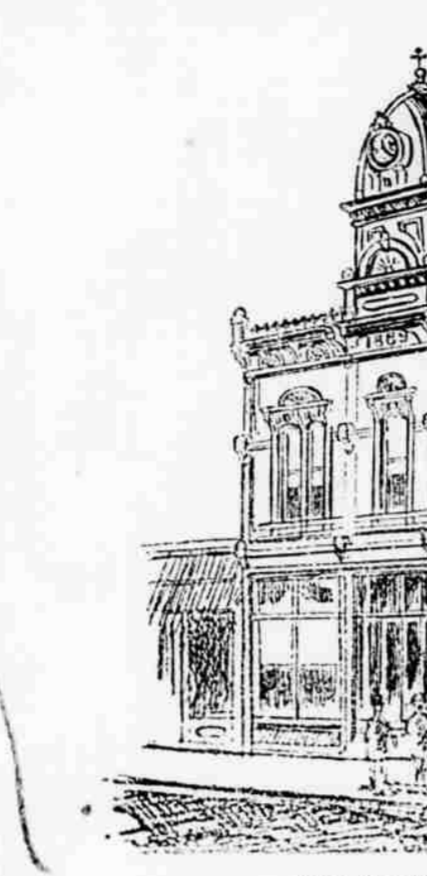
Sam Mullen, a hop grower, who lives on the southern east of Albany was in the city yesterday.
