At last the iniquitous trusts have found an advocate. He signs himself Chas. F. Beach, Jr., and furnishes the Forum with a sophisticated article in their defense. He says that "the trust is the nineteenth century offspring of over production, small profits, competition rampant and labor organization." The sophistry of such a definition is plain to even the way faring man. When the aggressive millions of wealth pile up on the screws to aggregate to itself the more rapid accumulations of other millions it is folly to attempt to blind intelligent reading men with the cry of over-production. He further on says "the trust cannot, with safety to itself, raise the price to the consumer to a point where other capital will be tempted to embark in its business—that is, to a point beyond the normal profit—but it can, by new economies in manufacture, cheapen without limit the first cost of its product, and thus enlarge its gains within the four walls of its own factory without inviting competition. Here the

self-interest of the trust works benefit to the public. It keeps present selling prices low, and it stimulates economies in production which must eventually insure to the benefit of the public." The untruthful dodging of this assertion is apparent in the trusts is to first render it totally impossible for any competition, and then advance the price beyond the normal profit. This Forum writer makes a poor argument.

English justice and jury trials have been often quoted and compared with those of our own country, usually with the intent of bringing discredit on our jury trials. The case of Mrs. Maybrick has called public attention to the subject and serves to correct many of these ideas. The Friend remarks that the Maybrick case appears to have convinced sensible English people of two things—that there is something wrong with a system whereby the Judge virtually directs the jury's verdict, and that an appeal to the Crown is not a sufficient safeguard in all criminal cases, for if the Judge is to tell the jury what its verdict shall be, where is the advantage of having a jury at all, and if a Judge's reputation is considered of higher importance than a sinful woman's life, how shall she obtain justice?
