THE FIRE RECORD.

The Chicago Tribune in referring to the recent disastrous fires on the Pacific Coast says that the coast may well claim the distinction of being the lurid section of the United States in 1889.

Washington has five large fires to its credit, footing up \$27,350,000 as follows: April 19, Cheney, \$250,000; June 6, Seattle, \$15,000,000; June 22, Vancouver, \$100,000,000; June 5, Ellensburg, \$2,000,000; August 5, Spokane Falls, \$10,000,000.

Then comes the fire at the little town of Linkville in this state last Friday, which destroyed nearly \$200,000 worth of property.

In these fires the business interests of each of the twelve towns were substantially wiped out. Such a destruction as this is almost unparalleled in the record of fires in the country and opens up a most suggestive field for investigation for the insurance companies.

The enterprise and rustic character of the towns of this coast was exhibited in its fullest force. Business was only temporarily suspended, and all of the burned towns are rebuilding bigger and better than ever.

FACTS ABOUT RAILWAYS.

The interstate commerce commission has issued its annual report, prepared by Mr. Henry C. Adams. This shows that the total mileage of the railways in the United States on the 30th of June, 1889, was 149,901.72 miles, or one mile of road to every 20.14 square miles of country.

In a recent speech Gladstone had the following kind words to say in referring to the rapid increase of the population of America: "I wish to recognize American's right to be considered, prospectively at least, and even now to some extent, the great organ of the powerful English tongue."

Two Russian men-of-war are said to be cruising in Uncle Sam's fishing pond in the Behring sea, watching events there. The czar, however, will probably not care to interfere in the fishery squabble.

There is small doubt that Slogger Sullivan really believes that he would be an ornament to congress. Sullivan, like most Bostonians, is not afflicted with modesty, and when he sees men sent to con-

gress purely because they have money, he can't see why he should not get similar honors on the score of muscle.

It is announced that it is a part of the plans of the Union Pacific to extend their lines in Oregon and Washington within the next few years. General Manager Kemble says the Northwest is a great country, and it is the policy of the company to build many miles of new road here in the near future.

Hon. SAMUEL S. COX, known as "Snauc" Cox who recently visited Oregon, died at his home in New York City on Tuesday at the age of 65 years. He had served over twenty years in congress and was one of this country's able men.

This has been a year of fires on the Pacific Coast and floods in the Eastern States. The former destroyed several million dollars worth of property, and the latter many thousand lives besides millions of property.
