DUTY OF NEWSPAPERS

Perhaps no recent action of a newspaper, in invading domestic quiet and dragging personal matters before the public, bears as tarished and culpable a phase as loss that of the New York World publishing the sensational account of Dr. David Tilton Brown's suicide.

Dr. Brown was removed and sent to Europe and placed under treatment until he recovered and his physicians gave directions that he should remain quiet and above all things that no reference be made to his past trouble and public life and work.

It is high time that enlightened public opinion was awakened to the danger of the unbridled license of a sensational press. The newspaper is intended as a means for the dissemination of news and useful information, but the invasion of domestic privacy for the mere gratification of morbid or idle curiosity is not the function of a true newspaper.

The soldiers home at Santa Monica, California, which possesses present interest to Albany as two of its recently admitted inmates have been for a number of years among our well known citizens, is under the charge of mismanagement and investigation.

The growth of the Catholic church in this country keeps pace with the other denominations. At the recent laying of the corner stone of a Catholic church edifice in Washington Cardinal Gibbons said: "I rejoice in the growth and progress of the Catholic religion, because I am convinced that the growth of the Catholic faith in this country will more than any other means promote the welfare and stability of our American institutions."

At Coffeyville city, Indiana, on a recent Sabbath, lightning struck a church during Sunday school service, killing two young ladies in one of the classes.

MORE THAN ONE CROP.

Too much cannot be said upon the subject of a diversity of crops. An Ohio Farmer very truthfully says that a farmer should not depend on any one particular crop, but cultivate such a rotation as his land is best adapted to, especially such as is wanted to be consumed on the place.

Farming is considered the most independent occupation in the world because the farmer can grow his own meat, bread, butter, fruit vegetables and materials to make his own clothing; but if he omits to do this and grows only one crop for market, he is just as dependent as other people, and as likely to be imposed on by high prices and damaged material.

The managers of the Central Pacific railroad, it is announced have decided not to rebuild the burned out snow sheds along the line, except in the extremely deep cuts, and to depend upon the rotary snow plows to keep the track clear in the winter months.

A WEEK'S business in this country and Canada amounts to quite a sum. A Boston authority says that a table compiled from dispatches from the managers of the leading clearing-houses in the United States and Canada shows that the total gross exchanges for the week ending September 14th, were \$1,066,269,435, an increase of 7.3 per cent compared with the corresponding period of last year.
