EDITORIAL NOTES.

The Oregon Steam Navigation company, of Portland, have purchased the steamer City of Kingston, one of the handsomest boats on the Hudson river, and will bring her around the Horn.

The girl who was espoused to Louis Lutz, the Chicago anarchist who blew the top of his head off in prison, was recently arrested for stealing clothing and jewelry from the lady who employed her as a maid.

An Italian who acted as banker for his laboring countrymen in New York city, recently skipped out with eighteen hundred dollars, leaving behind in his safe for his depositors the sum of seven cents. It is not recorded how the division of the assets was made among the creditors.

The Hamilton baby, whose mother has been sentenced to two years imprisonment, was sent to its mother recently. Probably the imprisonment of Mrs. Hamilton will be merely nominal as her aristocratic husband still sticks to her, by that act showing some little worth at least.

It is affirmed that leprosy the ancient loathsome disease that was and is so much dreaded, is spreading all over the world. As its spread is coincident with that of the Chinese people, among whom it has always been rife, it follows as a matter of course that its spread is due to that nation.

A YEAR ago Ex-President Cleveland's strength in the state of New York, in comparison to Governor Hill's following was, as 18 to 14. By recent manipulation Governor Hill stands 25 to Cleveland's nine. It is understood that the indications for the nomination in the democratic presidential convention between the two leading candidates stands about in that proportion.

A St. Louis German lady recently took the law into her own hands, in the shape of a thorough made cowhide whip, and gave a lasting dose of it to a young man who had engaged himself to her daughter, representing himself as a single man. Later developments proved that he had a wife and children in Scotland, his native country, and the irate mother vindicated her daughter's escape from the vile rascal in the manner mentioned above. As there was no legal redress, she was perfectly justifiable in the action taken.

PENNSYLVANIA, being a large producer of iron, comes in for an immense amount of abuse as being the sole recipient of favors from the tariff on iron and steel. But such is not the fact. It is estimated that the southern product of pig iron this year will reach 1,500,000 tons, and as the total production of all the Union, which embraces the outputs of several states other than Pennsylvania will scarcely reach 7,500,000 tons, it may be safely claimed by protectionists that the tariff on pig iron benefits an immense section of the Union directly and the whole nation indirectly.

The actual foundation for the stories of fabulous wealth, hidden in mines that have previously been worked on the sly by individuals long since passed way, but rediscovered or likely to be rediscovered by some remaining but lately found out trace, are generally very thin. One of them was recently fully exposed in the Maria Roman mine in California, which was a circumstantial narrative of the discovery of a mysterious silver mine worked by an old Indian woman, now resident near Carmel mission.

Now it turns out that the silver which she brought to Monterey to exchange for goods was melted silver plate stolen from a former employer. She herself left the country for Lower California years ago, and the two men who were quoted as corroborating the story have been dead for a decade. Thus perishes another promising romance of early days.

The ebullition on the part of the English colony on the north, over the seizure of the British sealers is amusing to behold. Apparently there is absolute danger of Uncle Sam being swallowed bodily, from the blustering talk that is indulged in. The latest phase of the situation is that if the cruiser Rush should venture into Victoria harbor she will be chewed complete up by the sealer crews assembled there, but whether such threats have been made or not is entirely immaterial, as they will never be carried out if they have been made. If the Rush goes into Victoria the government will be in duty bound, under the rule of international comity, to defend her, if she needs defense; for to allow a government vessel of a friendly power to be attacked by a mob, or armed force, in a British port would be a thing unheard of, and one which the British government could not defend. Unless Great Britain did protect the cutter it would be a casus belli at once, and England is not looking for war with the United States, any more than we are searching for a pretext to declare war against her. It is entirely safe to say that the Rush will go and come entirely unmolested, just as a British cutter or man-of-war would do in our ports.

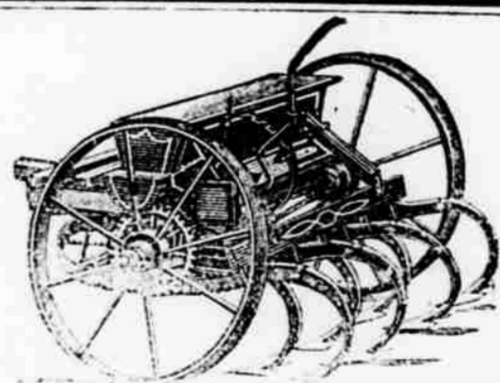
