The different republics, Honduras, Guatemala and San Salvador have already signed the treaty, and it is understood that Costa Rica will do the same.

The people having charge of the matter of furnishing Stanley with his mail matter, while in his late African expedition, seem to have been very remiss, not even forwarding matter to places where he could get it when he emerged from the dark recesses of that dark continent. He has been left for nearly three years with absolutely no knowledge of what has happened in the civilized world. Even when nearing the coast there does not seem to have been any provision made for furnishing him with newspapers. When he reaches civilization he will have to devote several days to reading up a condensed record of all these months that he has spent in a country where the newspaper is unknown and all intelligence passes from province to province by word of mouth.

On the first day of this month there died in New York an ex-journalist, Samuel Wilkeson, whose life work has been one of importance to the country, and of activity and research. He was before and during the war correspondent for the New York Tribune in Washington, and Senator Seward employed him to prepare the facts for a speech upon a trans-continental railroad. His acquired information upon that subject, his energy and ability, brought him into the notice of the Northern Pacific railroad projectors, and led to his acceptance of the position of secretary of that company, which position he held at the time of his death.
