be fine for Justice Hoyt to perform the ceremony in the marriage that he is shortly to contract. Probably that is about as important work as they will engage in anyhow, and it is to be hoped that the senator for whose benefit the act is taken will prove a good husband to the wife he marries.

SENATOR VOORHEES of Indiana is out with a long preamble and resolution upon the tariff question, which probably indicates the line of demarcation between the two parties. Voorhees assumes that a protective tariff cannot be a tariff for revenue, and he demands that the tariff be restricted to the actual needs of the government, and that import duties on all articles of necessity be reduced or removed entirely, leaving the revenue to be collected upon articles of luxury.

A contemporary very pertinently says that if Voorhees knows anything at all of fiscal matters, he must know that the government may collect only enough in import duties to meet its actual expenses and yet maintain a complete and equitable protective system. The point which he suppresses, for he cannot be ignorant of it, is the distinction between imposing duties on competing and non-competing articles of import. The American plan, which is the Republican plan, is to lay duties on competing articles, in order to shut out undue foreign competition; the English system, which is the Voorhees system, is precisely the converse. The English system is to place the duty upon such articles as tea and coffee which are not competing articles, and which we suppose Mr. Voorhees would call luxuries, falsely so for those articles have passed into such general use that they are no more luxuries than are any other articles of food.
