Call for a Republican State Convention. A Republican Convention for the State of Oregon, is called to meet at the city of Portland on Wednesday the 10th day of April, 1890, at 11 o'clock a. m.

Bakers, Benton, Chickamauga, Galtop, Columbia, Cook, Curry, Douglas, Gilliam, Grant, Harney, Jackson, Josephine, Klamath, Lake, Lane, Linn, Malheur, Marion, Morrow, Multnomah, Polk, Sherman, Tillamook, Union, Wasco, Wheeler, Washington, Yamhill.

The same being one delegate at large from each county, and one delegate for every 175 voters, and one for every fraction over one-half thereof cast for or against at the time of election of 1888.

The primary election to be held on April 15th, and the county conventions on April 16th, unless otherwise ordered by the proper county committee. All voters who favor the Republican policy of American markets for the products of American labor, liberal support of our own resources, and the protection of every voter in the nation, in the right to cast a free ballot and have it fairly counted, are cordially invited to attend the selection of delegates to the Republican State Convention.
