THE ALBANY COLLEGE.

The Presbytery Recommends That a Portion of the Grants Be Sold.

Rev. E. R. Prochard, Prof. E. N. Condit and Wm. Fortmiller, of this city, who have been attending the meeting of the Presbytery of Oregon in Portland, have returned home. Mr. Prochard was elected as one of the delegates to attend the general assembly, which meets at Saratoga Springs, N. Y., in May next.

President E. N. Condit, of the Albany college, reported an attendance of 132 for the year, the largest ever known in the history of the institution. He called special attention to the needs of the school and bespoke substantial aid from the Presbytery.

The committee on the Albany college reported as follows: Your committee recommend: First—That the Albany Collegiate Institute be maintained as a high rate academy.

Second—We recommend to the board of trustees that the charter be so changed that eight directors should be residents of Line county instead of thirteen.

An Increase in the Sch of Gen us of Over a Third Since the Year.
