EDITORIAL NOTES.

A DIBASTROUS forest fire in New Jersey has destroyed \$25,000 worth of timber.

A BEET sugar factory is to be established on Grand Island, Nebraska, the machinery for which will shortly arrive, it having been shipped from Germany via New Orleans. It is to be hoped that the experiment will prove a success, and that beet raising will soon become a profitable undertaking. It will do much towards relieving the present situation of the husbandman of the country by giving them another and a profitable crop to raise.

On the subject of over production as the cause of the decline in the prices of products, that is at present quite a discussion among the newspapers, perhaps the majority taking the grounds that the solution of the trouble in that respect is to be found in the mere matter of over production. Other papers, notable the Chronicle denies this statement, and show conclusively that such is not the fact. The Chronicle winds up an article upon this subject by saying that the truth of the matter is that the price of wheat is a sort of standard of prices for farm products, and that wheat has been forced down by the practical demonization of silver. The English market, which is the great overflow market for American wheat, was offered as a free gift to East Indian wheat-growers by the studdity or rascality of some of

our would-be financiers, who either could not or would not see the connection between wheat and silver. It is very easy at this late day to talk about overproduction, but when a market has been deliberately sacrificed it is time to think about underconsumption rather than over production. The condition of the American farmer is not a favorable one at the present time, but the remedy is not for him to abandon his farm, but rather to lend his aid to a readjustment of the financial situation by which he may be directly and immediately benefited.

It is astonishing how American girls will continue to run after European men, with the examples before their eyes of the outcome of nine-tenths of the marriages of that kind. The story told by the Pittsburg heiress who married the Count of Montecarlo, though it may be somewhat exaggerated, is a good thing for American girls to read. It carries its own moral of the utter folly of a rich girl expecting generous treatment from a foreign adventurer who hatters his title for her money. These men, despite their surface polish of fine manners are genuine barbarians who look upon a woman simply as a source of revenue and value her solely according to the amount of her dower. Their lords and masters may not beat them as the Count beat this Pittsburg girl, but they will eat the bread of humiliation and all their womanly modesty will be dragged in the dust.

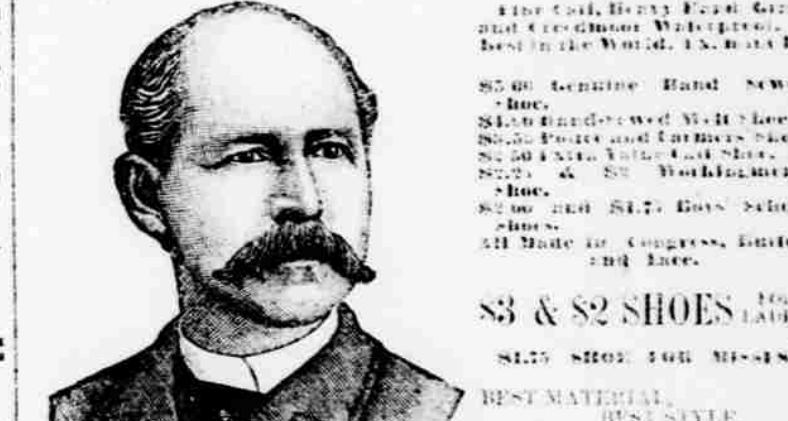

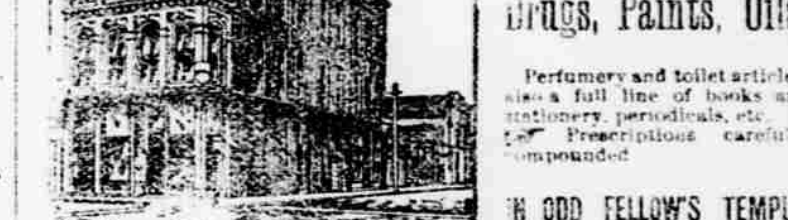
