It is found that a most effe composition for fireproofing ext r ior surfaces may be formed ly slacking a sufficient quantity freshly burned quickline of the best grade, and when the slacking is complete there is added such an amount of skin milk, or water in its absence, as will make a liquid of the consistency of cream. To every tengallons of this liquid are added, separately and in powder, | 21 stirring constantly, the following ingredients in the order named: Two pounds of alum, twenty-four ounces of subcarbonate of potassium or commercial potasti and one pound of common salt. If white paint is desired no further addition is made to the liquid, though the whiteness is found to be improved by a few ounces of plaster of Paris. Lampblack has the effect of giving a number of shades from slate color to black. What ever tint is used, it is incorporated at this stage, and the whole, after being strained through a sieve, is is run through a paint mill. When ready to apply the paint is heated nearly to the boiling point of water, and is put on in its hot condition. It is found that the addition of a quantity of fine white sand to this composition renders it a valuable covering for roofs and crumbling brick walls, which it




