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SENATOR BECK DEAD.

He Dies Suddenly from Heart Disease in Washington.

A NEW YORK SENSATION.

Obituary Shipped Back to Mainer—The Union Pacific Buying New Stock—Destructive Hurricane.

WASHINGTON, May 23.—Senator Beck, of Kentucky, dropped dead in the Baltimore and Potomac station in this city at 4 o'clock p. m. today.

At a quarter past 4 o'clock Mr. Harris interrupted the proceedings in the senate and had read a bulletin announcing the death of Senator Beck and moved an adjournment. The motion was agreed to and the senators and officials gathered around Harris, expressing to each other their sincere sorrow at the sudden death of the statesman who was so much loved and respected. Ingalls instructed the assistant sergeant-at-arms to proceed to the railroad station and ascertain the facts and make all proper arrangements to have the senate flag half-masted. Senator Beck had just arrived from New York, accompanied by his daughter, Mrs. Goodloe. He got off the train with the rest of the passengers and walked with his daughter the entire length of the platform and through the gate. He seemed to walk with an effort and to breathe with labor, but these symptoms were the usual accompaniments of exertion with him for some time past. After passing through the gate he and his daughter stopped and were joined by his private secretary, who had brought a carriage to take them home. A few words were exchanged in regard to the care of the baggage, when the senator suddenly turned pale and with the remark, "I feel faint," fell into the arms of his companion. They could not support his weight and he dropped to the floor, where he swooned away. Willing hands were numerous, and lifted the body which was taken into the office of the station master about twenty feet away. When the doctors arrived at the station examination only was possible, but sufficient to satisfy the doctors that death resulted from paralysis of the heart.

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A RESORT TO ARMS.

The Result of the Strikers in the Old World.

SENSATION ABOUT BISMARK.

The Eight Hour Movement Gaining Ground in the United States as Well as in the Old World.

BERLIN, May 23.—The first prominent result of the May day agitation has been a formidable movement among manufacturers, merchants, miners and others employing a large number of hands to promote the formation of a German union against the strikers. The idea had its origin in the communications that passed between the merchants and manufacturers association here and kindred organizations in other places regarding May day demonstrations at a time when the celebration threatened to paralyze trade. If the plan is carried out a league will be formed covering Germany with a network of employers associations. A speaker at Chemnitz reflecting the opinion of the majority of employers hailed the May day fiasco as a victory of masters over the men. Most of the newspapers draw similar conclusions.

BARCELONA, May 23.—Riotous strikers held complete possession of this city yesterday. The strikers compelled the employers to leave work; in consequence no newspapers were published yesterday. Mounted police charged the rioters. The latter resisted, finally compelling them to retire. Three regiments arrived and the Governor issued a proclamation and threatened death to the strikers who interfered with men willing to work. The strikers this evening have again assumed a threatening attitude and more trouble is feared.

LOST AT SEA.

A Grain Vessel in a Storm—Captain and Four Men Drowned.

VALPARAISO, May 23.—A report has been received from San Francisco, Chile, May 21, when in latitude 35° south longitude 78° west she experienced heavy weather during which her decks were swept. Captain Armour and four of the crew were washed overboard and drowned. Her cargo of wheat valued at \$67,000 was partly jettisoned.

AN INVADING HORDE.

A Steamer Load of Chinese Shipped Back to Mexico.

SAN FRANCISCO, May 23.—There was a lively time at the steamer wharf today, occasioned by the transfer to the Calima of several hundred Chinese immigrants for Mexico. In all 277 Chinese were transferred. Among them were three who yesterday tried to bribe the customs inspector to let them in a boat and they offered him \$500 to do the work. He accepted the money and subsequently arrested them. It was found that the Chinese could not be prosecuted on account of being on a British ship. It was decided to allow them to leave for Mexico.

TWO GOVERNORS MEET.

The Formal Opening of the New St. Louis Bridge.

ST. LOUIS, May 23.—The new St. Louis Merchants bridge was formally opened with imposing ceremonies. A special train bearing Gov. Francis, of Missouri, and staff, secretary of the interior, Noble, officers of the Merchants' Bridge and terminal railroad company and guests was met in the center of the bridge this afternoon by another train bearing Governor Fifer, of Illinois, and his staff. The two governors met and clasped hands on the center span. The special train then crossed to the Missouri side, where addresses were made by Governors Francis and Fifer.

TACOMA MURDERERS FOUND GUILTY.

TACOMA, May 23.—Frederick Hoy was today found guilty of murder in the second degree for the murder of Enoch Crosby in Oct. 1889. Geo. Howe was convicted last week in the same degree as an accomplice of Hoy in the murder.

Seattle's Population.

SEATTLE, May 23.—The population of Seattle proper, according to the final reports of the census enumerators to-night is 43,376.

Earthquake in Nevada.
