actual trial, because it consumes
too much time. The result is that
three-quarters of all large civil
suits arising out of commercial
differences are settled out of court,
and the trial is merely the formal
closing of the matter. That may
be the case with suits of that
nature but the observation of the
outsider upon this subject, is that
the practitioner is perhaps as re-
sponsible for the law's delays as
are three-fourths of the courts in
disposing of cases.

In spite of protestations to the
contrary, it is a plain fact that
Governor Penney and his co-
workers on the ticket now before
the people, make their main issue,
and their strong canvas, upon the
simple and out and free trade
doctrine. Their advocacy is for
free raw material, free wool, and
the removal of all protection to
American laborers. The plain
outcome of such a policy is the
destruction of the flocks that now
form one of the main sources of
wealth for Oregon and the reduc-
tion of wages to the European
standard. Their platform and
their utterances upon the forum in
the canvass so far prove this, as do
all antecedents in the premises.

The Oregonian shows this plainly
when it says: "If there were any
doubt on this point—as there isn't—
it would be settled by the record
of proceedings in the senate short-
ly before the final vote on the bill
authorizing the secretary of the
treasury to classify worsteds as
woolens which the president ap-
proved yesterday. During its dis-
cussion Jones of Arkansas moved
an amendment placing wool on the
free list. All the democratic
senators present—seventeen in
number, voted aye; all the repub-
licans present—thirty-four, voted
nay. This completes, confirms and
strengthens the record. The
democratic party is for free wool
always and everywhere, in con-
gress, in national convention in
Oregon, in theory and in practice,
in purpose and in act. It is only
important to insist upon this be-
cause certain responsible leaders
of the Oregon democracy are talk-
ing it upon themselves to declare
that the party platform does not
mean free trade in anything.
Democracy means free wool every-
where.
