A RICH NATION.

The First Figures Received from the Census of 1890.

A DECREASE OF STATE DEBTS.

Chinese Smugglers Arrive in New York—Apparatus by the President—The German Catholics.

WASHINGTON, May 27.—The census office today made public the first results of the eleventh census, in relation to state and local debts.

It consists of a preliminary report on the indebtedness of 25,000 counties in the United States. The reports show that principal of the state debts at the present time to be \$24,079,817. This shows a net decrease in the total debt of the country during the last 10 years of \$1,439,493. This decrease is the result of a number of decisions, the most notable being those of California, \$11,210,127; Middle States, \$11,357,482; Southern States, \$2,922,964; Western States, \$3,792,230. The total bonded debt of the United States is \$719,175,751. This shows a total net decrease of \$1,551,897,719 in the state and municipal debt in 10 years.

The total bonded debt of the 25,000 counties in the United States and territories is \$1,119,724,950. The floating debt is \$14,938,881. There is a net decrease in the total debt of the country in the last 10 years of \$1,124,779.

SAN FRANCISCO, May 27.—The Chronicle's Fresno special says: San Joaquin and Kings rivers are higher than ever before. About Elk Horn many thousand acres of land are inundated. Several hundred acres of the finest wheat land of the Laguna de Tache grant are under water and what promised to be a splendid yield will not pay for harvesting.

Below Hamptonville the San Joaquin has broken its banks and hundreds of acres are covered with water. Bridges on both rivers have been washed away. Both streams are in a rapidly rising stage and what will be a splendid yield will not pay for harvesting.

At Eureka the banks are in danger and should they break the entire country will be covered.

Snow in the mountains has only commenced to melt.

DESERVES HANGING.

A Woman Bound and Grossly Outraged by a Tramp.

NEWARK, Cal., May 27.—A tramp entered the house of Mrs. Hall, about nine miles from here yesterday. He found her alone with a child and a dog. He bound her hands and feet and then proceeded to outrage her in a gross and brutal manner. He threatened to kill her if she did not consent to his demands. She screamed and the neighbors were aroused. The man was shot and killed. He is believed to be a member of the same gang that recently killed a woman near Eureka.

MILWAUKEE, May 27.—In connection with the German Catholic society this morning H. J. Spohnhorst, of St. Louis, said that the "Bennett Law" presented a political question to Catholics which they could not ignore. It directly affected the welfare of their institution.

Bishop Flash in an address referred to the "Bennett Law." He upheld the rights of the church to appoint its own pastors when its interests were at stake. He was followed by Bishop Ketter, of Green Bay, who attacked the "Bennett Law" in the bitterest manner.
