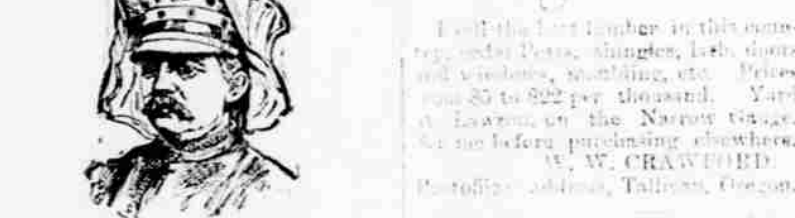

MANY KILLED AND WOUNDED.

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MEMORIAL DAY.

How It Was Observed at Oregon's Metropolis.

Portland, May 30.—Memorial day was observed in this city to-day by a general suspension of business. In the afternoon exercises consisting of a parade, participated in by the grand army posts of the city, national guards and citizens in carriages. The procession marched through the principal streets and at the plaza appropriate services were held. A large number of persons visited the cemetery and relatives and friends of the deceased veterans paid their respects to the memory of the dead with a profusion of flowers. In the evening special memorial services were held in the New Park theatre.

Portland, May 30.—The business houses suspended and the people generally observed the day. Many states and residences as well as vessels in the harbor were decorated with the stars and stripes. Over 1000 men paraded, including all the military and many civic bodies, and four hundred grand army men were in line, including 22 ex-prisoners of war, who marched in body carrying a banner on which was inscribed "Survivors of Andersonville and other prisons of the late war." J. W. Ferguson, speaker of the last house, delivered an oration at the armory hall.

Cleveland, May 30.—The Garfield memorial statue at Lake View cemetery was dedicated to-day with imposing ceremonies. In the presence of President Harrison and cabinet members of congress and others from all over the United States.

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
