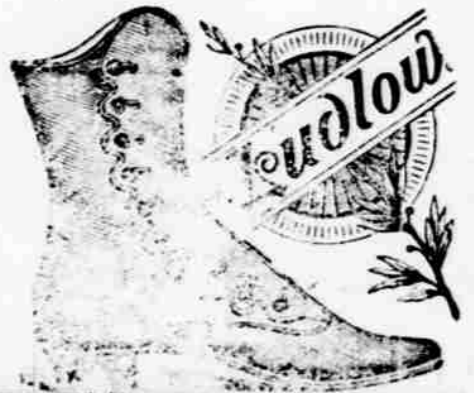

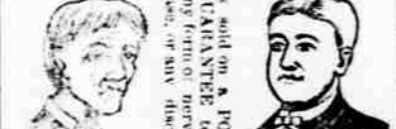

The Southern Pacific Railroad

Threatened With a Strike.

SEATTLE MURDERERS JAILED.

The Cruiser Charleston Ordered Back
to Honolulu—Yamhill Will Get the
Census Keenest.

SAN FRANCISCO, August 27.—The
reusal on the part of the South-
ern Pacific officials to treat with a
grievance committee representing the
trainmen on various divisions has
angered the members of the com-
mittee, and the outcome can-
not be predicted. Superintendent
Phipps said today that the com-
pany has decided upon the entire
reconstruction of its pay system.
New rates will go into effect
on October 1, and will extend to
conductors and brakemen on both
passenger and freight trains, and
to switchmen. While the com-
pany has virtually conceded all
the demands of the men, it will
treat with them only as employes,
and not as representing various
labor organizations.

THE CRUISER CHARLESTON.

She is Ordered Back to Honolulu
to Protect American Interests.

WASHINGTON, August 27.—Orders
were today issued for the flagship
Charleston, which has just arrived
at Seattle, Wash., from Honolulu,
to return at once to that port to
assist in protecting American in-
terests in the Hawaiian is-
lands. This action, based upon
Acting Rear Admiral Brown's re-
port, indicates a serious aspect of
affairs in Hawaii.

SUCCESSFUL TRIAL TRIP.

The New Cruiser San Francisco
Wins the Premium of \$100,000.

SAN FRANCISCO, Cal., August 27.—
The official trial of the new cruiser
San Francisco occurred this morn-
ing in the harbor. The trial was
successful and resulted in a success-
ful trial over four consecutive hours,
during which time the cruiser
maintained the average speed of 19.51-
100 knots per hour and won the
premium of \$100,000 for her
builders.

AN IMPORTANT DECISION.

Anybody Has a Right to Pat in a
System of Water Works.

LOS ANGELES, August 27.—Super-
ior Judge Cheney rendered a
lengthy decision today against the
water company and in favor of
E. L. Stein. The water company
claims the exclusive franchise to
furnish water, and the decision
is in favor of Stein, holding that
Stein or any other party had a
right to run water works. The
case will doubtless be taken to the
supreme court.

THE CUTTER RUSH.

She is Driving British Sealers
From the Behring Sea.

SAN FRANCISCO, August 27.—
From information received by the
cutter Rush, which arrived here
yesterday, it is learned that the
revenue cutter Rush was at
St. Paul's island August 15. She
is not making any seizures, but
is simply ordering sealers out of
Bering sea under threat of seizure.
In every such case the sealers
have left the sea. The cutter
had not arrived at Oumalaska when
the Arrago left.

SALEM NEWS.

SALEM, August 27.—Wm. Fair-
fax, aged 78, who imagines being
pursued by Mexicans seeking to
kill him, was brought here to-
day from the coast.

Cashier Atzelsberger, a native
of Germany, who has been wand-
ering in the woods in the vicinity
of Mt. Angel for some time, was
examined here today and com-
mitted to the asylum. The cause
of insanity could not be learned.

Was Not Removed.

PHOENIX, Ariz., August 27.—The
report sent out from Tucson say-
ing that Governor Wolfley had
been removed is without foundation.
It emanated from a series of rumo-
