The latest story of outrages to Russian political exiles may be exaggerated, but the facts, when they are received from official sources, will probably show another case of the brutality of the guards that finally become unendurable. The exposures made by Kennan appear to have had no effect in lessening the horrors of Siberian exile. The prisoners are marched like so many cattle and housed at night in vermin-infested convict stations. Any one of ordinary refinement would prefer death to such treatment. The frequent revolts of political prisoners furnish the best proof of the cold-blooded atrocity of this scheme of placing all exiles on the same level. The latest slaughter on the road to Irkutsk was due to needless cruelty on the part of the Cossack guards, and, as usual, the revolt of the prisoners led to the shooting down of men and women though they had been so many wild beasts.
