It is very possible that the sentiment against death by electricity may have originated with these two classes.

So long as society insists on retaining the death penalty as a portion of its code of laws there is little room for sentimentality over the mode of execution adopted. The murderer must be put to death and whether it be done in one way or another matters very little, provided no unnecessary suffering or torture be inflicted on the doomed man. Probably the certainty of his fate is the keenest torture which he could undergo, and the lapse of time between the passing of the sentence and its execution an eternity of misery. It is in the supreme moment can count for but little, and the physical pain, if any there be, may be a welcome relief to the mental agony.
