contrasted republican America with monarchical England, much to the disadvantage of the latter. Among other things said by Carnegie was to express the hope that before she passed away the people of his native land would resolve that they must be consulted as to the successor, tenure of office and the amount of compensation. This was cheered to the echo, as was also his reflection on the English pension system which gave £30,000 to the Admiral who battered down the mud forts of Alexandria while standing behind the steel walls of his ships, and General Wolseley a similar amount while Sergeant Richard Brown, one of the six hundred who led the charge at Balaklava was allowed to die in a workhouse.

Apparently it makes a vast difference whether a measure is introduced and advocated by our own party or not, to a great many people; much more so than does the measure itself or its effects when it is put into execution. Take for instance, the Mills tariff bill and the McKinley tariff bill upon the one item of sugar. The supporters of the Mills bill have been the veritable enemies of the McKinley bill on that subject and yet as shown by the Seattle Post-Intelligencer the McKinley bill makes the best showing upon the subject. The Intelligencer points out that under the present law sugars not above No. 13 pay 1.40 cents duty; above No. 13, and not above No. 16, pay 2.75 cents; above 16, but not above 25, pay 3 cents; above No. 20 pay 3.50 cents. As proposed in the Mills bill sugars not above No. 13 were to pay 1.15 cents; from 13 to 16 were to pay 2.20 cents; from 16 to 20 were to pay 2.40 cents; above No. 20 it was to be 2.80. Under the senate bill No. 13 is to be free; from 13 to 17 is to pay 0.30 cents; above 16 the duty is 0.60 cents.
