MILLS FOR SPEAKER

The election of a Speaker by the Fifty-second Congress, which assembled in December, 1891, will be watched with more than ordinary interest

During the present campaign, and more especially since the election, Mr. Mills has come out squarely as a free trader, that is, as an advocate of a tariff for revenue only

If, therefore, he should be elected speaker of the house in December, 1891, it may be assumed without fear of contradiction that the presidential election of 1892 must be fought on the issue of free trade or protection

For these reasons it is to be hoped that Mr. Mills may succeed in his present ambition and be chosen speaker. It is much better that the question of policy should be tried fairly and squarely without any disguises or any side issues

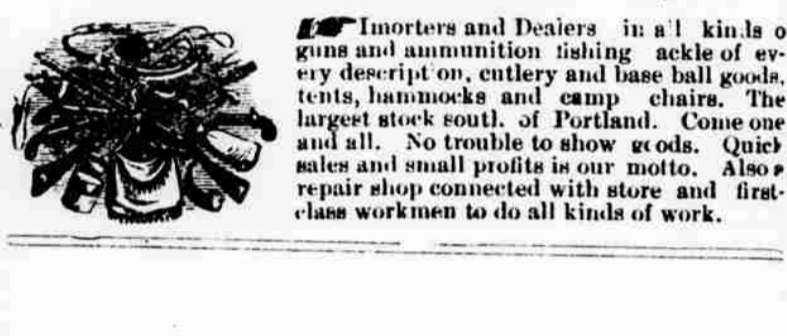
