Notice to Electric Light Consumer.

Owing to the great loss in "Burn Outs" of incandescent lamps on the Westinghouse circuits, it becomes necessary for the Electric Light Company to either charge for lamps so burned out or advance the rate. Therefore, consumers will take notice that after January 24, 1891, the rate on 16-cp lamps burned until 9:30 p. m. will be charged \$1.00 per month as a basis rate, in place of 50 cents as heretofore, for each lamp, and larger lamps in proportion; and lamps burned a later hour than 9:30 will be charged \$1.50 for a 120-watt light and \$2 for all night, same as the present rate on 16-cp lamps burned until 9:30 p. m. and paying for a 9:30 light and letting their lamp burn all night or a later hour than contracted for, will be charged accordingly without further notice.
