WOMEN AS JURORS...

An eastern paper recently told an amusing and characteristic story regarding the eligibility of women to serve as trial jurors.

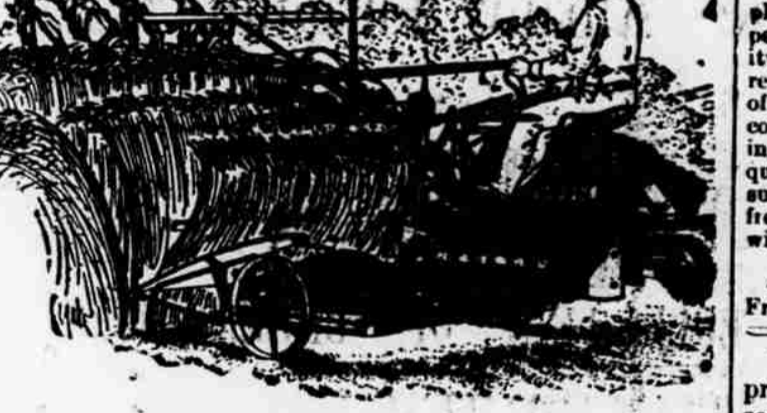
