From these the agricultural results have been obtained, and it will certainly surprise the public to know that in the last five years the total wheat crop alone has been equal to the total product of silver and gold, while in Oregon, which has produced in twenty-one years \$17,513,787 of precious metals, the wheat product has amounted in value to \$142,653,627.

They will probably make a goodly sum out of the transaction as the prospect is that stocks will advance just as soon as the big crop commences moving.

Two thousand cabinet makers in Chicago struck for eight hours per day. The employers say it is a dull season and so they are glad that the workmen are laid off. The result will be that the men will lose several months wages without gaining the adoption of the eight hour plan.

MISSOURI farmers alliance men are making strenuous efforts to defeat the sub-treasury plan. The great majority of the alliance men, however, are heartily in favor of that scheme, and will not be satisfied until it has had a trial.
