AMMONIA BAKING POWDER MUST GO. Baking Powder Bill Passed by the Minnesota Senate.

The recent newspaper discussion of the dangerous qualities of ammonia comes from the alarming increase of its use in baking powders.

Following is the bill recently passed by the Minnesota senate: A BILL FOR AN ACT TO REGULATE THE TRAFFIC IN AMMONIA POWDER.

Section 1.—Any person who shall knowingly sell or procure the sale or offer for sale of any packages containing baking powder...

Section 2.—The sale or offer for sale of the substance mentioned in the foregoing section in packages not stamped, marked, branded or labeled as therein required...

Section 3.—This act shall be in force on and after its passage.
