THE ELECTION COMMENTS.

The view upon the results of the elections are various, and of course of the same color as the spectacles used by the observers.

The Chronicle thinks that Governor Campbell of Ohio takes his defeat philosophically, though he is not quite fair in his way of accounting for it.

The fact is that Governor Campbell tried to butt down a stone wall with his head when he attempted to defeat the cause of protection on a clean-cut issue.

The English press, as usual, take a distorted view of the situation for the most part. The London News, for example, says that McKinley was probably elected not as a protectionist, but as a moderate opponent of free silver.

But whether the comments be right or wrong, it is obvious that the principal interest was centered on the Ohio election, for the reason that in that state alone were national issues directly involved.

It takes a great deal of testimony to convince those whose minds are already made up, and that too with a predisposed bias.

The South American states seem to be periodically in a state of eruption and revolutions. They cannot continue in a peaceful condition for any length of time.

The telegraph correspondent of the press, in different parts of the world, should be selected with greater care, or at least the ones

that serve in that capacity should select their news with more care. Take the recent accounts that have been telegraphed from Chili, first was the story of Balmeada's escape, a pure romance, and later the sinking of the United States vessel The Baltimore, in the harbor of Valparaiso, a still worse fiction.

The Chilean trouble will probably dissipate itself as completely and fully as did the little brush with Italy. The warlike preparations in the navy yards, however, is an episode that did not make its appearance when the diplomatic war of words with Italy was in progress, and is an indication that the Chile trouble is really of more importance.

The British war office is bound to practice economy, and therefore wades in on that line to have a great saving inaugurated. This it accomplishes by cutting off the gold lace upon the uniforms of army officials, thus making a saving of the enormous sum of £100,000.
