A Murdered Man's Jewelry.

MARYSVILLE, Cal., Nov. 25.—
While digging a hole to bury a pet
dog, Annie Bradley, a young girl,
unearthed a gold watch, chain and
locket taken from the body of
George Hall, who was murdered
here July 15 last year. The place
where the watch was found is the
rear yard of John Almont,
superintendent of the Marysville
bag factory, who recently purchas-
ed the place and moved there.
The place is about two blocks from
the scene of the murder.

Horses and Mules Burned.

MARYSVILLE, Nov. 25.—A fire at
10 o'clock last night at Marcus
station, about fifteen miles from
this city on the Knights Landing
road, totally destroyed a large
barn and contents, including 27
head of horses and mules, 120
head of hay, and about 50 tons of
barley. A windmill was also
burned. Marcus, who owned the
property, estimates his loss at
about \$8000. Partly insured.

CHINESE OUTRAGES

**More Missionaries Murdered and
Their Stations Burned.**

MANY NATIVES MASSACRED.

The Authorless Powerless to Quell the
Revolt—Troops Harried to the Scene
of the Trouble.

PARIS, Nov. 25.—A dispatch
received here from Peking which
confirms the statement that well-
armed bands have devastated a
whole district in the northern part
of China, and that they have pil-
laged and burned the Christian mis-
sion stations. In addition to the
destruction of mission stations at
Layou and Sanchi, there were over
100 converted natives massacred
by the blood-thirsty bands. The
station at Gei-hou was sacked and
burned. The troops in charge of
the mission, a Belgian by birth, was
killed by the mob, and several
other Christians were also massa-
cred. The natives have heretofore
been quiet, and there was no sign
in the district that a revolt was
meditated. The local authorities
have taken no steps to suppress
any outbreak, and when the
natives rose they met with no
military opposition, for the officials
were practically helpless. It may
here be stated the local governor,
in his report of the occurrence to
the Peking government, does not
place the blame upon the natives
of the province, but attaches the
responsibility for the crimes to
bands of Mongolian robbers, who
he says, made a raid through the
district. Whatever the truth may
be, the general government has
taken steps to prevent any further
outrages on foreigners or native
Christians in this district. Under
orders from Peking, all the troops
available were, immediately on
receipt of information regarding
the trouble, dispatched to the scene
of the disturbances.
