From the Virginia Chronicle, Feb. 17th. Daniel Boone Baker, a native of Kentucky, aged 27 years, sent to the Nevada State Prison from Elko county...

After taking leave of his family he was conveyed to Albany and placed in jail, completely broken down in spirit and reckless enough to take his own life if such a thing was possible.

PLATFORM OF THE INDEPENDENT PEOPLE OF OREGON.

Resolved, 1. That citizenship and the advantages thereof shall be open to all persons who will exert themselves to secure public economy, enlargement and reduction of taxation in every practical way.

2. That we view with alarm the reckless extravagance of the State and National Governments in the multiplication of officers...

3. That we favor the adoption by the National and State Governments of all reasonable measures of securing cheap transportation; and to this we favor liberal aid from the General Government for the opening and improvement of our harbors...

4. That all property rights, individual and corporate, shall be subject to laws that will give all proper legal encouragement and protection to corporations...

5. That we demand a return to the salaries fixed by the Constitution for State officers; and we condemn all schemes that have been devised to increase such salaries by indirect means.

6. That we demand the repeal of the Librarian Printing Law.

7. That we demand equal rights for all citizens, and demand special privileges to none.

8. That the interests of the people demand competition in the transportation of freight to and from our seaboard; that we are ready to favor any system that will secure to the State the largest and best of the ports of the Willamette; but would hold fast to the State and Lock Company to a strict compliance with the existing contract.

9. That we especially condemn those acts of the Legislature that they have enacted to deprive the public lands of the State in large tracts, to the exclusion of poor men and men of moderate means...

10. That the removal of a faithful and respected citizen, merely because of his political opinions, is a gross abuse of power...
