CHICAGO, Jan. 16.—The great storm which swept over the entire country last week has been followed by a freeze, the like of which has not been experienced since the memorable winter of 1864.

Dispatches from the Northwest report 125 fatalities already. At Aberdeen, Dak., Bessie Stanfield, a pretty 19 year old teacher, three miles distant, left school during the storm to go to a farmer's house.

Four children frozen to death in a schoolhouse at Mellette. The teacher left them to get assistance, and her body has not yet been found.
