

'Although tributary to Holland, it is an independent State, politically without importance, yet happy, rich, and since time immémorial, governed and defended by women The sovereign is indeed a man, but all the rest of the government belongs to the fair sex. The King is entirely dependent upon his state council, composed of three women. The highest authorities, all State officers court functionaries, military command-'ers, and soldiers are, without exception of the female sex. The men are agriculturists and merchants. 




