CORPORATE MONOPOLIES.

The next great division of parties in American politics will be opposition to and war with monopolies. The organized power of these vast corporations is obtaining a controlling influence over the Government of the country that is irresistible. The absolute indifference and insensibility to individual rights and private interest by these monopolists is as marked as was ever the jusness of authority in feudal times. Never did Saxon slave wear the badge of a more galling servitude than does the American people to day to the great corporations. Gradually they have so debauched the morals of the community, silently they have so demoralized public virtue, that it really seems as though there was no end and no limitation to corporate exactions and demands. There are in the city of San Francisco, we think (and we speak it with a reservation), one or two or three honest officials, but they are mostly in those offices where the temptation is least. There may be an honest man or two in the Board of Supervisors, but we shall not risk our reputation as judges of men by mentioning their names. We hear stories told of our Assessor that indicate either that he is a dishonest man or that there are slanders abroad in the community. We see the officers of these great corporations doing acts that only from their very magnitude save their perpetrators from conviction and imprisonment as felons. Gould steals millions restores a part, and the offense is condoned. We see our managers, directors and presidents of corporations in the lobbies of our Legislature debauching and bribing members for coin. We know that a California Legislature is not an honest body, and that each year it is worse than the preceding year. We know that politics is rotten and corrupt, from the primary election to the Senatorial election. We know that the same thing is true of New York and Pennsylvania, and we know that it is true of the Government at Washington. The Senators of the United States buy their positions for money, and in turn sell themselves for coin. Corporations expend their money with reckless extravagance among lawmakers to purchase the enactment of laws that enable them to rob the people. It is not yet necessary to bribe the Judges to give these corporations false interpretations of the law, because so far the laws are made for the corporations. This most alarming condition of things challenges the attention and will soon arouse the action of the people. It will soon become insupportable, and when it does then great corporations will be scattered like straws in a tempest. At present they are bound together by the mutuality of self-interest. The press is the natural friend and ally of the people. As the great body of the people are honest, so the great body of the press will be true and constant to the right. Individual members of the press will be seduced and bought and bribed. The Tribune has been sold to a great corporation, and it shows the the power of money, and illustrates the strength and cunning of the telegraph monopoly that it can afford to purchase the leading journal of America, a property costing a million of dollars to aid in upholding its right to rob the people. This same monopoly may secure the Call and Bulletin and arrest for a time their failing concerns by telegraphic favors; but as sure as there is an honest Providence the New York Tribune will lose its influence and the Bulletin and Call will find their level before an intelligent people. It will not do for the Journals to make pretense of fighting one monopoly while they are upholding another. It is dishonest on their part and as

shallow as it is wicked. We repose ourselves in confidence that the time is coming when an honest and intelligent people, following the lead of a fearless and unpurchasable press, will break themselves loose from these corporations, and will place them where they belong, under the foot of an indignant and outraged people.—*Chronicle.*

The above is a complete and full endorsement of the course pursued by the REPUBLICAN. Every word of that article is true and more might be said. We join the *Chronicle* in its cry, down with monopolies, and raise high in its stead, the equality of man and the rights of the people.

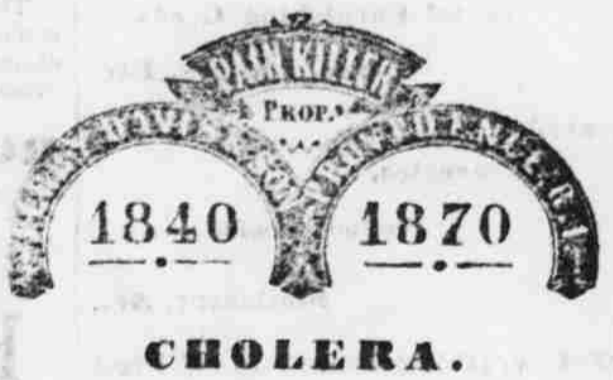

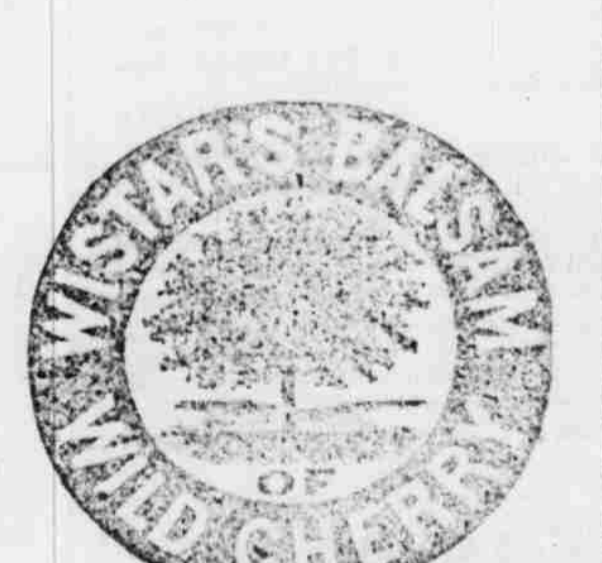
