THE END OF TYRANNIES.

One of the ablest English writers of the last century, who published a work on "The Characters of Nations" in 1770 just six years before our "Declaration of Independence" lays down this axiom:—"The fluctuating, unstable condition of a all States that are established on mere force and violence is a truth unanimously attested by the records of all ages." How true this is! Even the great Persian Empire, founded on the conquests of Cyrus, never enjoyed a single day of settled repose. The prodigious monarchy form under Alexander the Great, terminated with the life of that conqueror; and the realms that arose from its dissolution were nothing, from their beginning to their end, but scenes of mutual slaughter and devastation. Even "immortal Rome" perished at last under the incurcursions and assaults of people whom they had long insulted. The great and glorious power of Charles the Twelfth of Sweden was at last annihilated from the same cause. It was the pride and arrogance of Louis Fourteenth, that brought his power to the ground, and nearly destroyed the French monarchy. It was precisely the same thing that brought Spain down from the glory of being the first monarchy in Europe to the disgrace of being one of the poorest. We could fill a volume with these illustrations. But we only wish, at this time, to call attention to the fact, that one half of the United States is now ruled with a "force of violence" greater than was ever used by Rome to any of its colonies, and more haughty and insulting than any authority ever claimed by Louis the Fourteenth, Charles the Twelfth, or Alexander the Great. Are we, here in the North, such unreasoning fools as to imagine that any government in this country can be permanently and peaceably settled upon such a basis? If Grant and his Cabinet, and Congress, could be forced to read and reflect upon history for six months, they would make haste to get out of the policy they have inaugurated. And this they would do (if for nothing else) to save their own necks and to preserve for their children the plunder they have taken. The wretches already feel the danger of their positions—a danger from which they can see no escape, but in the utter breaking down of the manhood of the Southern people. This they hope to accomplish in to ways, viz, by bribing with some sort of position, the most worthless creatures like Orr, of South Carolina, and Longstreet, of Louisiana, and by intimidating the rest. This is their only hope. If the manhood, or honor, of the Southern people survives, they will send the names of their oppressors into history as the most abhorred scoundrels and tyrants of the nineteenth century.—N. Y. 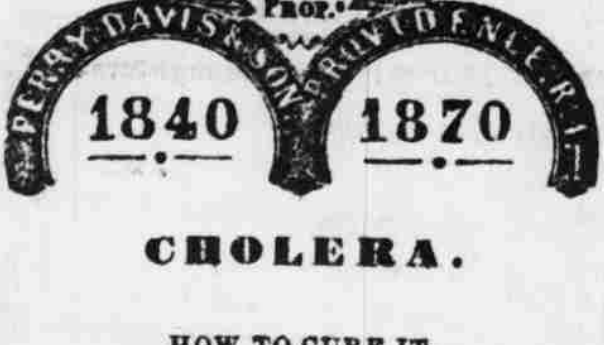

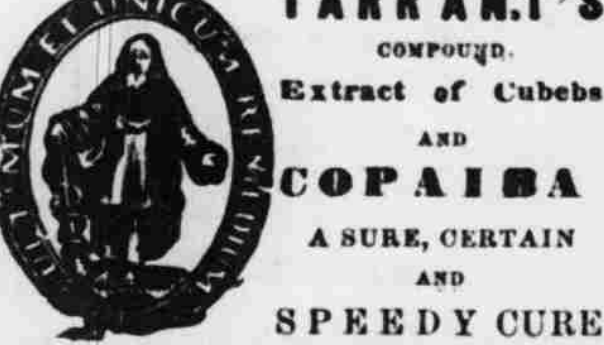

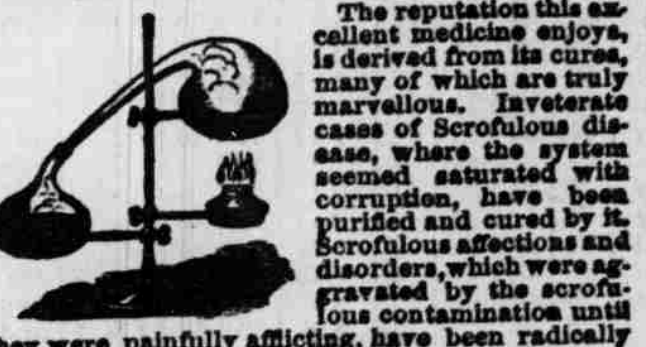
