IN THE SHADE.

The next matter looked into was the source of supply of the water used. It was found that some bottlers and those engaged in supplying the trade with the mineral waters, such as the Seltzer and Croton waters, after thorough filtering, while others use water from driven wells. It is certainly not advisable to permit the use of these waters for drinking purposes, although it may be doubtful whether the strong solution of carbonate under pressure may not act as an antiseptic to kill any living putrefactive organisms.
