W. H. Wehrung, president of the state board of agriculture, and M. D. Window, secretary of the board, were in this city Wednesday. Every animal or article must be entered for competition in the name of owner or maker, whose number must be indorsed on the entry card.

Entries may be made with the secretary at his office in Salem, six days before the commencement of the fair, or three days before at the fair grounds.

In the matter of prizes for premium-takers, horses of various descriptions will be awarded sums varying from \$1.50 to \$20.

The idea of having each county's exhibit returned intact (except in the case of perishable articles) then to be placed on exhibition in the county is a good one and will undoubtedly strike a popular chord.
