INSURRECTION NOT WAR.

That our readers may learn how those at the front in our new Philippine possessions look upon the tactics of certain papers in the United States regarding the condition of military affairs in the islands, and also that the public may know what encouragement the rebels are receiving from Mr. Bryan and his lieutenants, we republish the following editorial from the Manila Times, of September 25, 1900:

Plain-spoken correspondents of home papers are very emphatic in declaring that "the war in the Philippines" is not yet over. They enlarge upon the constant petty attacks made on U. S. troops by bodies of insurrectos and almost lead their readers to believe that Manila itself is practically in a state of siege.

Now that the period of amnesty has expired, it is high time that our friends in the States were enabled to form an accurate estimate of the position. The word "war" no longer applies, as war can only take place between two powers to which the world at large accords independent rights.

Nobody of course can prevent the insurrectos from calling their raids by any name they like; but the Spanish and Tagalog press can be prevented from investing them with the dignity of a war as between two contending powers.

powers. Phrases have much effect on people generally, and the impulsive, hot-blooded Filipino is no exception to the universal rule. The non-recognition of a state of war as existing between the Philippines and ourselves is of peculiar importance at this moment in view of Aguinaldo's recent proclamation in which he promises his followers independence as the immediate result of Mr. Bryan's expected election to the presidency.
