GERMAN TARIFF DEBATE.

The German Reichstag is now engaged in a bitter struggle over the proposed revision of the tariff.

The Imperial Chancellor declared that the Emperor was highly satisfied with the bill; that it had been carefully prepared and was properly adjusted to their economic life and would secure foreign treaties on acceptable conditions.

A short time since the GAZETTE showed the inability of German farmers to raise a sufficient food supply, and expressed the view that the measure was planned to influence reciprocity with the United States.

There is great industrial stagnation in Germany. Her manufacturers are overstocked, her factories comparatively idle. They need our food-stuffs and would gladly exchange their manufactured products for our grain, flour and meats.
