

AGAINST THE MERGER.

United States Attorney General Knox will institute proceedings against the merger of The Great Northern and the Northern Pacific railroads into the Northern Securities company.

The argument that because such corporations or trusts are incorporated by a state in the exercise of its sovereignty they cannot be controlled by federal authority never was a valid one, for the moment they engage in interstate commerce they pass within the authority of the national government.

We have always held that congress has ample power under the constitution as it is, and if adequate laws did not exist congress should supply them.

Working to these ends such combinations can do no ill. But so great is their power and influence that it is necessary for the state to maintain a vigilant supervision over their conduct.

Like the mill of the gods the government moves slowly. It has not been moved by the evil foreboding of the timid, nor influenced by the mouthings of demagogues; neither will it turn aside from its purpose of inaugurating and maintaining a just control over these great corporations.

THE PRESIDENT'S DECISION.

The decision of the president on the appeal of Admiral Schley should be no surprise to those who carefully followed the proceedings of the naval court of inquiry and who are familiar with the naval operations culminating in the destruction of the Spanish fleet off Santiago.

The actual battle was a fight by the captains. Schley is not entitled to any more credit than the captain of his flag ship, the Brooklyn—nor to so much for daring courage and dash as the captain of the little Gloucester.

For the honor of the navy and the men behind the guns it is to be hoped that the action of the president closes the case and that so much of history shall never repeat itself.
