

THE SUBSIDY BILL.

Last Monday the Senate passed this measure. Few public measures have been more fully discussed both in Congress and the public press.

The necessity of the measure is found in the fact that it costs about 25 per cent more to construct ships in our yards and to operate them after construction than it does in foreign ship yards and to foreign operators.

Nearly all the nations of Europe sail subsidized ships. Under these conditions we are unable to create a merchant marine. Our foreign carrying trade is in the hands of foreign ship owners, to whom we annually pay large sums for a service which every patriotic sentiment declares we should perform for ourselves.

The provisions of the bill are carefully drawn. Foreign built ships do not receive any part of the subsidy. Hereafter foreign built ships, though owned and operated by Americans, shall not be admitted to American registry.

The sums expended under this act shall not exceed \$5,000,000 per year until July, 1907, nor \$8,000,000 per annum after that date.

The final roll was 40 for to 31 against the bill. Four republicans voted against and one democrat for it. Senator Mitchell took an active interest in the discussions on the bill and voted for it.

A GRATIFYING CONDITION. As the time for holding the republican congressional convention approaches the fact becomes

more and more evident that Congressman Tongue will be re-nominated without opposition. It is gratifying to know that the people of this district have learned a lesson from the congressional districts in the East which wield such mighty influence in the House.

When we have in our republican delegation at Washington men who have served for twelve, sixteen and twenty-eight years we shall be able to command attention to our claim upon the government.
