The Italian Prune.

A. Sharples, of Goshen, Oregon, who has been about twenty years a close observer of the prune industry of Western Oregon and Washington, contributes an article to the Agriculturist, from which the following is an extract:

That there is a constitutional weakness in the Italian tree is, I think, clearly shown in the increase of that diseased condition known as the curled leaf, that the result of abnormal conditions in the terminals of the limbs and the small wood that is immediately behind the limbs; also that it is a condition that is developed and intensified as the tree approaches and reaches the bearing age.

Now if the trouble causing this diseased condition of the leaf was in the ground, the bark, the roots, the wood of the trunk or large limbs, this immunity of the sprout would not exist but it would suffer the same as the older wood.

The objection may be made to this idea that the curl leaf does not occur every year, nor with the same degree of intensity every year that it does occur.

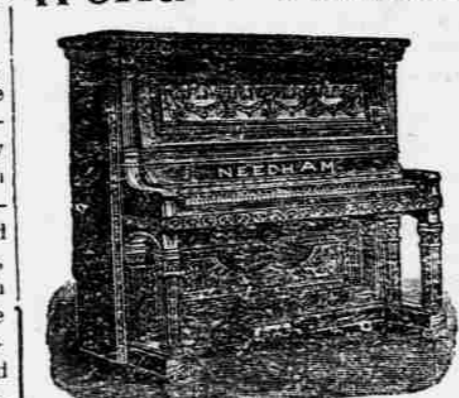
