Drowned at Nye Creek.

Mrs. Otto Kleeman and daughter, Miss C. G. Kleeman, of Portland, were passengers on Saturday morning's C. & E. en route home. They went to the coast last Wednesday intending to remain several weeks, but their visit was suddenly terminated by a distressing accident which resulted in the death of Mrs. Kleeman's son, William.

The young man, who was about 23 years of age, was in bathing at Nye Creek last Friday morning about 11 o'clock. The surf was light and being an expert swimmer, Mr. Kleeman was tempted to ride out on the swells too far from shore.

A thousand horror-stricken spectators, among whom were his mother and sister, witnessed his struggle. C. A. Burden, of Eugene, and Mr. Bush, of Salem, went to his assistance, and made an heroic effort to assist him to shore, but they were compelled to give up their task and battle for their own lives.

When the news of his son's death reached him shortly after its occurrence, he telegraphed for a special engine to take him and his son, Hugo, from Albany to Newport. This train passed through Corvallis that evening.
