CORVALIS ICE WORKS.

A Thriving Industry—How Ice is Manufactured.

One of the foremost and most flourishing industries in our rapidly-growing city is that of 'the manufacture and sale of ice. Ice is shipped from Corvallis to all Philippine, Mexican and Indian points westward on the C. & E. railway and many points eastward. It also ships to Dallas, Independence, Monmouth and as far north as North Yamhill, half way between here and Port-Liberty Car with forty-five land. The home trade of course is the heaviest of all; with the Exempt and Veteran Firemen picnics, hanquets, socials, ice cream stands, saloons, hotels, butcher shops and a score or more of other demands the plant is kept running night and day to supply orders. The story of how steam is converted into ice this hot weather is a very interesting one as well as reassuring to us who are users of ice, because when the story is to:d you will agree that there can be nothing purer than artificial

The water is pumped from a well fifty feet deep, hermetically sealed and is clear and sparkling Cycle Brigade-Consisting of like the waters of a mountain stream. This water is boiled and converted into steam. The steam passes through a cooler or condenser and becomes water again -soft, velvety sterilized water. Physicians of this city purchase this water for medicinal purposes as none purer can be found. The Best single or double turnout process by which this purified tank into the freezing tanks is a precautionary one, no microbe or germ or bug of any kind can get into the water in any possible way. The water tanks are surrounded by numberless iron pipes, through which ammonia The parade will form in line gas is constantly being pumped. from the water and this extraction of heat is what really causes the water to freeze.

The gas which becomes heated is kept constantly circulating through a cooler or condenser reducing its temperature. If one were to visit the ice works the hottest day in summer he would find the ammonia pipes coated with about an inch of snow. It requires a pressure of 150 pounds of ammonia gas to the square inch upon the inside of the pipes these hot days to cause the water to freeze solid. In winter the weather is cool and only 90 pounds is required. When the temperature of the water registers 32 degrees the treezing point, the ammonia will be just a little lower. The water tanks are partially submerged in a strong solution of brine to keep them from freezing to the pipes. Each tank contains about 100 pounds of ice. When it is removed from the freezing box warm water is poured over its galvanized covering and it slides out easily upon
