The Leaders of the party, and men of influence in it are the firmest friends of the trusts, and responsible for their continuance. Judge Parker, in a case before the Court of Appeals in New York, at the April term last year, wrote an opinion in favor of the Wholesale Druggists' Trust. This decision can be read by any one on page 137, volume 67 of the Northeastern Reporter.

The anti-trust law was framed by a Republican, was passed by a Republican House and a Republican Senate, and was signed by a Republican President.

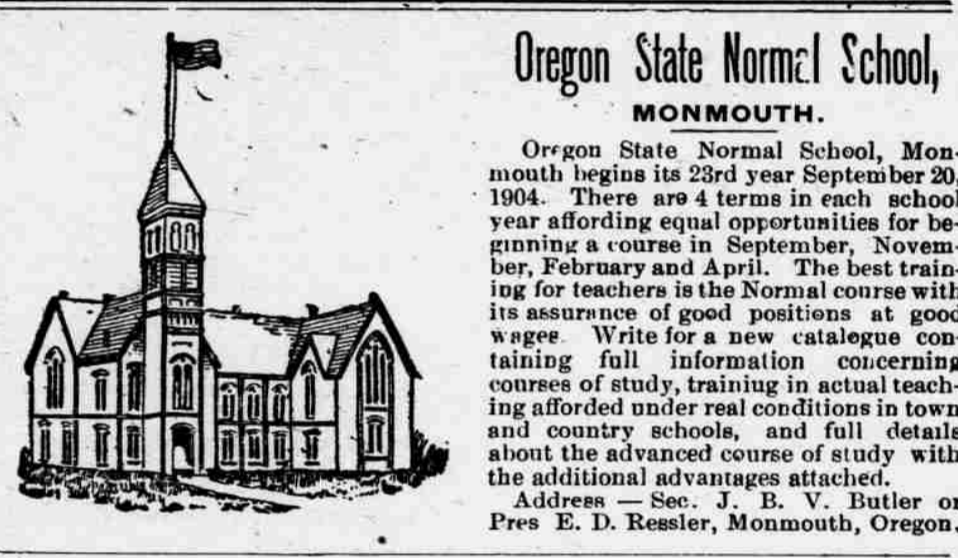
