Tilmon Ford was born in 1845 anm in Marion county until 1865 when be went to Idaho to try his luck in the mines. Beng successful with his pick and shovel,
he accumulated sufficient means he accumulated sufficient means
to enable him to enter Willamette University, where he graduated in 1870 . He immediately
took up the study of law and was took up thitted to che bar by, the Supreme Court in the Fall of 1872 . He opened a law office in this
city soon after and city soon after and has engaged in active practice ever since. In 1880 he was nominated and elected a Representative in the
Legislature from this county on Legislature from this county on
the Republican ticket, and was author of the bill enacted during that session which located and
provided for the building of the State Insane Asylum. Fie was re-elected to the Legislature in
1882 and served through both 1882 and served through both
sessions as an active member of sessions as an active member of
the House judiciary committee. the House judiciary committee.
Aithough a powerful working Aitbough a powerful working
member of the Legislature, Mr. member of the Legislature, Mr
Ford was mucl given to display of forensic ability, bu when he did take the floor to ad diess the assembly upon any sub
ject he had the reputation of carject he had the reputation of car-
rying his point in nearly every rying his point in nearly every
instance. Up to the time of an instance. which befell him in Febrnary, 1905, by which he suftered a fractured hip, Mr. Foró had been prominently identified with Republican politics. He presided over several county and
state corventions,
