R. and connected with every improvement and society in Corvallis, is lying at the point of death in Roseburg, where he was taken from his lonely mountain mining camp by the Masonic Lodge of that city, the members having learned of his pitiful and destitute condition.

While living here, Mr. Grant performed the heroic act of rushing into the burning Wells warehouse and rescuing his friend, Mr. Wrenn, from what seemed certain death. This brave man is now dying among strangers, apparently neglected and forgotten by his friends of former years.
