

There is something exceedingly refreshing in the Republican call for this county. The fellow who imbibes too much of the "how come you so" will often exclaim, "I will never do so any more."

The Swamp Land Frauds. Some time ago the Oregonian, in very strong terms, charged the present State officials with "standing in" with the swamp land grabbers, and made charges which, if true, require legislative interference. The law is plain that it is the legislative will that but a limited acreage shall be sold to any one person. If it is true as stated that the State officials are attempting to convey 4,000,000 acres to the syndicate of which Hen Owens is the head, it is in violation of the statute. The people should see to it that their legislators are men who have the stamina and ability to unearth these frauds, regardless of who it may hurt. It is an admitted fact that it is for the best interests of the State that these lands should be owned and held by actual settlers, instead of being held in large bodies for the purposes of speculation.

We are of those who believe that the earth was made for our habitation and that any system of government which attempts to parcel out to individuals or corporations vast tracts of the public domain for the purpose of speculation, is at variance with the best interests of the people and should be held accountable for their actions.

The executive department may be able to place these lands, which belong to the State, beyond legislative control. It is a well established principle, both in law and in equity, that fraud will vitiate all contracts and if these swamp land grabbers have been guilty of the frauds charged upon them by the Oregonian, they obtained no rights or equities by their filings, and the State officials can give no greater rights than the law recognizes. It is a matter for legislative interference and should be probed to the bottom.

Col. Hogg, president of the Oregon Pacific railroad company, in the conclusion of his speech to the citizens of Corvallis, charges M. C. George with defrauding the State of \$40,000 from Oregon. He says:

"Before bidding you good night, I must remind you of one or two things; I must take the liberty to tell you of a duty you owe to yourselves and to the State of Oregon. It is—be careful who occupy the seats in congress. They are non-political so far as you are concerned. Some of your representatives stand there opposing us as every point. Two years ago, without proper assistance from the Oregon delegation, but by outside influence, a bill was passed by which the house proposed to give us \$60,000. The senate committee proposed to give to Oregon \$40,000, of course for Yaquina. But the senators from Oregon surrendered the Yaquina \$40,000 for the mouth of the Columbia. Then followed an open fight on the floor of the senate, under the influence of which Senator Slater boldly proposed and contended for a specific grant of an extra \$50,000 for Yaquina. But when it came back before the house your delegate in congress deliberately threw it away for party purposes. I can prove this by documentary evidence. This may be unpleasant, but it is the truth and the whole truth. I stand by what I have said. I did not intend to say this to-night but my feelings have carried me away."

The committee request the personal attendance of delegates, making proxies the exception and not the rule; and that the precinct meetings be well attended, as the interest there taken will be recompensed by securing judicious action in convention and success in June.
