

FOREIGN TELEGRAPHIC NEWS.

The prevalent weather in England is very cold.
Mile, Nevada is enjoying marvelous success in Paris.
Sir John A. McDonald, of Ottawa, is reported seriously ill.
Four thousand barrels of oil were burned in Dublin last week.
Mr. Gladstone will probably go to the south of France to rest.
It is announced that Gladstone has recovered his usual health.
The police have discovered a secret dynamite factory at Tulle, France.
The French in Tonquin are discussing the occupation of Amnong, China.
The German Reichstag has adjourned for the customary Easter vacation.
The Abyssian troops were disbanded because they were outlaws and robbers.
Various friendly sheiks ask that a British governor be appointed for Tokar.
It is now declared that the finances of France are not in an alarming condition.
The Maori King sailed from Auckland for England, via San Francisco, April 1st.
Minister Sargent will resign the post at Berlin and refuse the St. Petersburg mission.
General Graham telegraphed from Egypt to London that the fighting campaign is ended.
Telegraphic communication between Berber and Shendi, Egypt, has been restored.
Recent discoveries of police officers have created a great consternation among Russian police.
A dynamite school has been established at Paris under the direction of Irish-Americans.
Latest advices from Khartoum confirm the report that the city is almost surrounded by rebels.
The second of Wiggins' twin storms was to have crossed the meridian at Halifax last week.
It is reported that Salvini and Mary Anderson will play an engagement together in London.
Prince Leopold, fourth and youngest son of Queen Victoria, died suddenly at Cannes last week.
The British advanced on Tameb and burned the village. The Arabs fled and the fighting ended.
Mary Anderson, after a provincial tour, will reopen at the Princess Theater, London, in the autumn.
The United States man-of-war Lancaster, flagship of the European section, has arrived at Alexandria.
Orders have been sent from London to General Graham for him to return immediately with all his troops.
Several large warehouses at Lyons have been burned. Damage, 500,000 francs. Thirteen horses were killed.
It is thought in Montreal that a flood is pending, owing to the height and constant rise in the St. Lawrence river.
The report that the Porte of Russia had demanded America to recall Minister Wallace is emphatically denied.
A Montreal man named Arpin, by the death of an uncle in Cleveland, Ohio, has left him a fortune of \$30,000.
The Minister of Public Instruction at Paris presented Victor Hugo a gold medal on the occasion of his 82d birthday.
The Duke of Argyll has an article in the Nineteenth Century on Henry George entitled "The San Francisco Prophet."
The Tenth Hussars of the York and Lancaster regiment and the Irish Fusiliers have embarked for Egypt for home.
In one German town it is asserted officially that 403 persons died from eating raw pork from one and the same hog.
The Mayor of Victoria, B. C., has announced his intention to suppress gambling, and has so instructed the police.
The British had a two hours' skirmish with the rebels near Tameb. Several rebels were killed. The enemy retired.
The land commissioners have reduced the rental of the Limerick property of Lord Londondown from £2,400 to £1,800.
A prince of the royal family of Annam has been convicted of prompting the massacre of Christians, and has been hanged.
Before the skirmish at Suakem Colonel Stewart sent a note to the rebels asking that if he would surrender his life would be spared.
The English government has shipped from Glasgow 270 emigrants, taken from the workhouse at Swinford, county Mayo, Ireland.
A dispatch from Dublin states that the Orangemen and Liberals of Ulster have organized themselves against Farnell and the Parnellites.
The Canadian government will appoint a commission to investigate the question of Chinese immigration, now agitating British Columbia.
One Berlin paper considers that America has conferred an honor upon Sargent which cannot be regarded as a victory of Bismarck's policy.
Sheiks Samar, Danilets and Scorsah have come in to tell Omar to assist in the capture of Osman Digma, whose prestige has been destroyed.
Bismarck has directed the Senate of Bremen to ask for admission into the Customs Union. The Senate is unwilling to do so, but must yield.
At Bismarck's dinner in honor of the Emperor's birthday, he greeted Sargent with a courteous bow, but shook hands with the other diplomats.
Buda-Pesth police have delivered seven thousand anarchists at Vienna for trial. They were in company with the assassins Steil, Macher and Kammerer.
The steamer Babco, bound from Liverpool for Havre, is ashore at Lands End, and full of water. All on board were saved by the rocket apparatus.
The Pope in his last allocution to the cardinals denounced the Italian violation of the rights of the church and demanded the restoration of temporal power.
Advices from Sudan say that several shocks of earthquake occurred at Agram and throughout Slavonia. A number of buildings in Dekover were damaged.
The jury has rendered a verdict in favor of Lady Colin Campbell, in her suit against her husband for divorce. The husband is the youngest son of the Duke of Argyll.
Reports are now that it was Bernard Coleridge, and not Lord Coleridge, who married Mary Anderson on the offer of marriage. Bernard is a son of Lord Coleridge.
Advices from Cairo state that the rebels are massed near the sixth cataract. The steamer proceeding from Shendi to Khartoum was fired upon and obliged to return.
A riot was precipitated at Pesh, Hungary, recently by striking iron workers. Troops were called out and fired upon the crowd, killing one man and wounding several.
A bill has been introduced in the English House of Commons restricting the sale of patent medicine until they shall have been examined and pronounced not poisonous.
It is asserted that negotiations are pending between England and America with a view of adding to the extradition treaty a clause which shall cover the authors of dynamite outrages.
At Swanton, Vt., a Sheriff's posse raided the Lake Champlain fishing grounds last week. Three fishermen were arrested and two forty-two junes were seized.

The black mare Cathedral sold for \$4,500 to John Cline & Sons, Rensselaer, Missouri.
Memorial Hall in the Illinois State capitol at Springfield, was dedicated last week.

Peter Schmitz, held at Chicago on the charge of having choked his wife to death, committed suicide by hanging last week.
The Pittsburg Chamber of Commerce protests against the passage of any of the hostile patent bills now before Congress.
M. Olmer, a prospector from Dayton, O., was captured by a band of Indians in Turtle mountain (Dakota) two weeks ago.
The Newark, N. J., Methodist Conference are investigating charges of immorality against Rev. George R. Breister, their pastor.
Last week, near Wellsville, N. Y., an insane woman shot her son and daughter, aged 8 and 12 respectively, and then killed herself.
Buffalo Bill's suit to recover sixty-one acres of land in Cleveland, valued at several millions dollars, has been thrown out of court.
Vanderbilt thinks that politics do not amount to anything, but is angered at having to pay duty on steel rails and pictures.
The Treasury Department has purchased 34,000 ounces of silver for delivery at the New Orleans, Philadelphia and San Francisco mints.
Theodore Herrick, alias Little Al, was arrested at Boston recently, charged with implication in the robbery of the Missouri Pacific Express Company's car.
The appointments of Medical Director Francis M. Gunnell, Surgeon General of the army, and Robert F. Clayton, of Georgia, Consul at Para, have been confirmed.
