D. L. Moody, the evangelist, is in Montreal, Can.

The dentist to the court of Italy is an American.

Vienna has an international fisheries exhibition.

It is said the Irish informers have founded a colony in Brazil.

The Right Hon. Henry Fawcett, Postmaster-General of England, is dead.

Italy has 4,800,000 lemon trees, which produce 1,200,000,000 lemons annually.

The re-appearance of cholera in France causes great alarm throughout Europe.

A London dispatch says that the Cunard and Gull steamship companies have arranged to amalgamate.

The Marquis of Londonderry is dead. His full name was George Henry Robert Charles William Vane Tempest.

Antonio Mula, editor of the *Tacna* (Chili) *Estadística Española*, has been assassinated.

Many of the principal cities of France sent workmen out to America to visit the Boston exhibition.

Winter weather, with its frosts, cold rains and fogs, is reported to be settling down upon London.

Low-priced cab drivers in Paris now carry a whip with a conspicuous knot of red ribbon tied to it.

One thousand men were absent recently from the Aberdeen schools through an epidemic of measles.

Says a Constantinople dispatch: Monsignor Azarian, Armenian patriarch, ill for several months, died last week.

Mr. Walter has suspended the publication of the *Summary*, the half-penny condensation of the *London Times*.

The ancient city of Nuremberg is to have next year an exhibition of goldsmiths' work, and a rare display is expected.

The Emperor of Germany will deliver an address of welcome to the delegates at the first sitting of the Congo conference.

The treaty for reciprocal passage of American and Mexican troops across the boundary line has been extended to October 31, 1888.

The London *Standard* is informed that the Crown Prince Frederick William will be appointed regent of the Duchy of Brunswick.

In the English commons last week, Frank O'Donnell, Home Ruler, was suspended for disregarding the authority of the speaker.

The King of Belgium has sent the Red Cross decoration to Commander Henry B. Seeley, U. S. N., for assisting a Belgium vessel off Brazil.

British Consul Hewitt has concluded treaties with chiefs of the African tribes on the upper reaches of the Niger river, and extended the English protectorate.

A supposed case of cholera has caused much alarm at Buenos Ayres. The steamer Bruzzo and another Italian steamer are detained at Montevideo.

Says a Madrid dispatch of last week: Floods at Alicante destroyed the Faubourg Caridade, and rocks thrown down by an avalanche battered down the old stone walls of the city.

The German squadron concentrating in west Africa comprises 55 guns and 1,300 men. Fernando P. will be the coaling station. The men will be furnished with white clothing and hats.

President Solomon, of Hayti, on the fifth anniversary of his landing in the presidential chair, the 23d ult., granted full and complete amnesty to all political offenders in the country as well as exiles.

Thomas Shaw, member of parliament from Halifax, who has heretofore been mentioned in connection with the postal department, has been appointed successor to the late Postmaster-General Fawcett.

Prime Minister Ferry has informed England that if China effects mediation without delay, or increasing further expenses by military operations, France will limit its claim of indemnity to 10,000,000 francs.

Anarchist Baruff has been sentenced at Vienna recently to six years' hard labor on the charge of high treason. The principal count in the charge was the posting of placards of an incendiary nature.

The Health Exhibition which was lately closed at London shows a profit of £33,000. The Christian Science movement, two medals, and two medals of silver and six diplomas for various exhibits made by them.

London advises state that both Liberals and Conservatives have issued urgent "whips" to their members to support the second reading of the franchise bill, which, it is believed, the Parnellites will oppose.

A dispatch from Foo Chow states that the Ki Pai forts have been repaired, guns mounted and torpedoes laid in the river, leaving a channel of only 100 feet in width. A return of the French fleet, however, is not anticipated.

The Austrian consul at Bombay telegraphs to Vienna that the cholera in a severe form is being sent from the Red Sea. The panic-stricken peasants refuse to furnish provisions to the people of the city, and the outlook is serious.

The Senate of Mexico has ratified the agreement between Great Britain and Mexico. The President approved of it, and cordial relations between the two governments are now consummated, after a lapse of many years.

According to native reports the rebels are concentrating forces on all routes leading to Khartoum. Native spies announce that El Mahdi has sent guns and ammunition to Osman Digma to enable him to resume operations on the Red sea.

The Suez Canal Committee will send a commission to Egypt, to examine and report upon a feasibility of widening the present canal, or whether it is necessary for building a second canal. De Lesseps and his son will accompany the committee.

Henry Labouchere, Radical member of Northampton, recently gave notice that he intended to make a motion providing for a change in the relation of the House of Lords and the House of Commons, so as to prevent the Conservatives from impeding legislation.

The Tonquin committee of deputies has voted a credit for reinforcement of the French forces. The ministers of war and marine intimated to the committee that if the conflict continued in Tonquin they would be obliged to ask for a further credit in December of 8,000,000 francs.

Prime Minister Ferry has announced to the Tonquin committee of deputies that England has offered to mediate between China and France, and has not yet made any official overtures to the Chinese government. *La Temps* states that France is negotiating direct with China.

The French Senate has adopted three articles of the Senatorial reform bill, providing for the election of 25 Senators by departments and colonies, and 75 by the Senate. The term of service is fixed at nine years, instead of five. Pretenders to the throne are declared ineligible to the Senate.

The other night 200 medical students of Toronto, Can., sallied out to "paint the town red." They began by assaulting a newspaper office, which had said something offensive to them. They then sallied out also, charged the mob and painted the sidewalks red, using their batons with good effect. There were three arrests.

The Radicals of the English parliament are combining to oppose a government compromise on the subject of the Home Rule bill, and its efforts to bring the existing difficulty to a close by the creation of Liberal Peers. The aim of the Radicals is to widen the House of Commons, and to gain the agitation for the abolition of the House of Lords.

DOMESTIC TELEGRAPHIC NEWS.

New York banks now hold \$34,195,000 in excess of legal requirements.

Wolfe Bros., dealers in hats and caps, Chicago, have failed. Liabilities, \$165,000.

A movement to place telephone wires under ground is now agitating St. Louis.

Three thousand men have signed the Murphy temperance pledge in Indianapolis.

Trouble with miners in the Hocking Valley (Ohio) are again assuming a serious shape.

Malaria-breeding pools in Brooklyn, N. Y., are being filled at a cost to the city of \$30,000.

The trial of Joseph Evans, for polygamy, was begun in the District Court at Salt Lake last week.

Rear Admiral Phelps, who recently commanded the South Atlantic station, was retired last week.

A bill providing for an increase of judicial salaries has been referred to a third reading in the Vermont Senate.

A colored preacher was committed to jail a few days ago in Natchez, Miss., for failing to perform duty.

Two hundred citizens of Columbus, O., have been fined for profanity in the public streets. One man has caused the arrests.

The delivery freight depot of the Louisville and Nashville road, at Louisville, Ky., burned last week. Loss fully \$100,000.

It is said that gold and silver mines chased the hands over the rest of the recent Owens-Murphy prize fight at Butte City.

Lena Haberl, 10 years of age, died at the female hospital in St. Louis the other day of trichinosis, caused by eating half-cooked pork.

For slipping on the snow on the dock of a ferry-boat, a recently arrived Italian Philadelphia woman has been awarded \$150.

Pat Kiernan has been sentenced to be hanged on December 12th, for the murder of Peter McCormick last June at Hunter's Point, L. I.

By an explosion in a dynamite mill near Robesonia, recently, three men were blown to atoms and a neighboring building was badly shaken.

The New York Central ticket offices in New York city last week began selling first-class tickets to Chicago for \$12, and second-class for \$11.

It has been proposed to furnish the railroads with grain cars built entirely of steel. It is said that more grain can be carried with less wear and tear.

The entire business portion of Silver Plume, Col., was burned a few nights ago. The loss is estimated at from between \$100,000 to \$200,000; insurance, \$55,000.

The house of James Cochran, at Ellijay, Ga., was destroyed by fire last week. His mother, 85 years old, was burned to death. The body of the child was found by the charred bones.

Abel D. Reed, merchant of 30 Broadway, New York, made an assignment last week for the benefit of creditors, to William Lindsey, giving preferences amounting to \$100,000.

Colonel E. A. Burke, Director-General of the World's Industrial and Cotton Centennial Exposition, announces that the formal opening will take place at noon, December 10th.

A well-to-do Stonetown, Pa., farmer, named Stoneback, committed suicide recently rather than pay his taxes, the tax collector being in the time in the house waiting for his money.

B. Haas, a German real estate agent of Jersey City, N. J., shot his wife, at their home on Union hill, last week, and then shot himself. Haas died almost instantly, but the wife still lives.

The earnings of the Union Pacific Railroad for the last month were \$18,500,000, a decrease of \$2,449,256 from the same period last year. Surplus earnings, \$7,822,839; decrease, \$2,223,586.

The New Jersey Central announces that the transfer books of the company will close on December 24, for the payment of the guaranteed quarterly dividend of 14 per cent after December 1st.

The street car drivers' strike in New Orleans has ended by a compromise. The men demanded \$60 a month, and the compromise agrees to \$55 for fifteen hours' work a day. The former pay was \$45.

Counsel for the receiver of the Pacific National Bank of Boston, in a suit against some 200 stockholders of the bank to enforce assessment liability, stated that the case had been withdrawn from jury trial, and would be heard by court.

Failures throughout the country during the past seven days are 236. There is a decrease of 27, and that of the previous week 258. Decrease arises in New York city, New England and middle states.

The general passenger agents of roads running south met at Chicago last week and made round-trip rates to the New Orleans Cotton Centennial Exposition from leading cities in the Northwest, on a basis of \$25 for the round trip from Chicago.

The ship Henry Hyde was launched at Bath, Me., last week. She is 2,783 tons burden, and is the largest ship ever built in Maine. She will be commanded by Captain P. Peabody, and will carry a charter for the San Francisco clipper business.

A suit for damages, it is said, is now pending against the jailer of a Leadville jail by a woman who was nearly frightened to death by being put into a "haunted cell," in which prisoners whom it is desired to especially punish are confined.

Two jail deliveries occurred in the state of Wisconsin last week, one at Appleton, where five prisoners made their escape by digging through a stone floor and out of the wall, and the other case at Neilsville, from whence two murderers and a horse-thief made their escape.

A couple of colored magistrates in Bolivar county, Miss., tried a capital case with a jury recently, and on a verdict of guilty, being returned in, sentenced the prisoner to death. On receiving a little legal advice they sentenced him to jail to await the action of the grand jury.

The recent sword contest at the Academy of Music, Cleveland, O., between Duncan C. Ross and James McGregor, for \$500 a side and the championship of the United States, was won by Ross by a score of 20 to 18, an excellent contest. McGregor was knocked off his feet four times.

In the United States Circuit Court in New York recently, papers were filed in the suit of Alexander Stewart, a lunatic, by his guardian, Benjamin F. Wheldon, against Henry Hilton, for the sum of \$100,000, claiming that he had sold him as one of the heirs of A. T. Stewart.

Kyrus Sullivan Gardner, a magnetic physician of Chicago, was shot and instantly killed by his wife in a fit of jealousy last week. After killing her husband, she placed the revolver to the head of her 18-month-old child and blew out its brains. Then she placed the weapon to her own temple and killed herself.

The store of L. C. Robinson, in Salisbury, Pa., was robbed last week. The suspected persons were negroes connected with the Buzzard gang. Constable Bowman found the robbers, four in number. The men attempted to escape, and Bowman shot and killed one of them (Jerre Green) fatally. John Boab, another of the party was arrested.

The steamboat Fannie Freeze was burned to the water's edge at the wharf in Madison, Ind., last week. Fire caught from a torch igniting hay, 400 bales of which comprised her cargo. Flames went up through the roof in less than half a minute, obliging the passengers and crew to jump into the river to escape. The boats' baggage of the crew, etc., are a total loss.
