President Cleveland has gone into the Adirondacks to spend the Summer vacation.

Bishop Undall, of the Mormon Church, has been convicted of perjury at Prescott, A. T.

The adjutant general of the army reports that the number of men in Oregon available for military duty is 33,000.

Lux & Miller, a California stock firm, have recently put 40,000 head of cattle on the range adjacent to Haney valley.

John G. Thompson, of Ohio has been appointed special agent of the general land office to investigate fraudulent land entries.

John Roach has received from the United States about ten million dollars during the last twenty years for ship building and repairs.

A monument will be erected in New York by the American Hebrews to commemorate the memory and virtues of Sir Moses Montefiore.

If precedent rules Mrs. Grant will receive a pension of \$5,000 per year. That is the sum that was voted for Mrs. Lincoln, Mrs. Garfield and Mrs. Polk.

It is stated that an alliance, offensive and defensive, has been formed between England and China, in view of a war between the former power and Russia.

The schedule of assets and liabilities of John Roach has been filed. It shows liabilities of over \$2,300,000. The nominal assets are stated to be \$5,181,000, and the actual assets \$4,481,000.

Portsmouth, New Hampshire, recently elected the entire Democratic ticket by 600 majority. This is only another evidence of the strength and popularity of the Administration of Grover Cleveland with the people.

The prohibitory liquor law of Kansas requires a statement by the purchaser and the druggist for every portion of rum sold, and this document must be filed with a county judge, the fee for his honor is five cents in every instance, and some of the judges enjoy handsome incomes from this source.

Capel, the Catholic convertionist, who is now in San Francisco, has been through Chinatown and is eloquent in detailing its horrors. He thinks the industrial phase of the Chinese question a trifling matter compared with the moral damage of social and business contract with the Chinese.

Next month the Kentucky distillers will have taxes amounting to \$4,500,000 to pay on 5,000,000 gallons of whisky in bond. This whisky has been mortgaged to its full value. If the government orders the whisky seized for the taxes, the distillers propose to bring suit against the collectors for damages.

The Grand Army of the Republic will hold its grand encampment next year in San Francisco. The committee on transportation have secured, it is said, the promise of round trip excursion tickets, good for a month's stay at the coast before returning, for \$60.00. They have some hopes, through competition, of getting this down to \$50. At \$60 the cost would be less than a cent a mile, which is getting rates pretty low.

Cholera is again exciting consternation among the people of southern Europe. In spite of attempts on the part of health officials to convince the public that the attacks of the disease are sporadic, the opinion is gaining ground that a real epidemic is spreading. In Spain alone the number of new cases reported daily reaches into the thousands. Entire villages are reported to have been deserted by their inhabitants. A strict quarantine is being enforced in the neighboring countries.

Acting Commissioner Walker, of the general land office, has declined to issue any more patents to the Northern Pacific railroad, pending a decision fixing the legal status of the road in this regard. He follows the rule laid down by Commissioner Sparks in relation to California & Oregon and the Oregon & California roads. The question at issue, briefly stated, is that the road was not completed within the time required by law and that until congress takes definite action in one way or the other no steps should be taken, to place the matter beyond the power of the legislative branches of the government to protect public rights.
